

Institutional Visiting Hours & Guidelines

Visiting Guidelines:

- ✓ Photo identification is required. Only current and valid identification including driver's license, passports, alien registration cards, visas, or a Mexican Consulate registration form will be accepted. Photo identification must be provided.
- ✓ Only parents, guardians or those individuals authorized by the Court may visit youth in the facility.
- ✓ **Visiting check-in time is 1:00 p.m. to 1:15 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. to 6:15 p.m. Visitors arriving after check-in will NOT be allowed to visit.**
- ✓ Children of **youth** are allowed to visit; however, visitation is by special appointment. Parent/guardian must contact Juvenile Hall staff to schedule a visit.
- ✓ No one will be allowed to wait in the Visiting Center lobby.
- ✓ Snacks may be accepted during visiting within the guidelines listed below.
- ✓ No purses, pagers, cell phones, cameras, and radios are allowed in the facility.
- ✓ Tobacco products of any kind, lighters, matches, firearms, knives, or weapons of any type are prohibited.
- ✓ Hostages will not be recognized for bargaining purposes during escape attempts by youth.
- ✓ Packages, letters or photos will not be allowed into the facility and may not be given to the minors during visiting.
- ✓ All letters, photos, birthday cards, holiday cards, etc. must be delivered by the United States Postal Service. No exceptions.
- ✓ Books and magazines are not allowed. These items are furnished to the youth by the facility only.

Snack Guidelines:

- ✓ Snacks may only be brought into the facility on visiting days, during normal visiting hours.
- ✓ The snacks for your child will be combined with snacks brought in by other parents of youth within the living unit. The pool of snacks will be available for all youth within the living unit who achieve enough points to attend evening programming.
- ✓ Upon a youth's release all snacks brought into the facility will become property of the Institution and will remain for future distribution to youth in the living unit.
- ✓ Two types of snacks are allowed into the facility (**NO EXCEPTIONS**):
 1. 2-liter soda plastic bottles soda (**Must be diet and caffeine free only**)
 2. Individually packaged single-serving potato chips (all varieties)
- ✓ Write the youth's first initial and last name on all items brought into the facility.
- ✓ All snacks must be store bought.
- ✓ No glass will be allowed into the facility.
