### NEW! Increased Construction Site Inspection Requirements Begin July 1, 2015

- Inspection frequency will be based upon a project's "Threat to water quality", using a system of Risk Levels which correlate to the SWRCB General Construction Permit (CGP).
  
- There are 4 categories of Risk Levels:
  - **Not subject to the CGP** (project is less than 1 acre or has obtained an Erosivity Waiver)
  - **Risk Level 1 / LUP Type 1**
  - **Risk Level 2 / LUP Type 2**
  - **Risk Level 3 / LUP Type 3**
  
- Required construction site inspection frequency by Risk Level:
  - **Not subject to the CGP** – Project will receive a pre-soil disturbance inspection and a project completion inspection.
  - **Risk Level 1 / LUP Type 1 or Risk Level 2 / LUP Type 2**– Project will receive a pre-soil disturbance inspection, monthly inspections and a project completion inspection.
  - **Risk Level 3 / LUP Type 3** – Project will receive a pre-soil disturbance inspection, bi-monthly (2 times per month) inspections and a project completion inspection.
  
- **Note:** Pre-soil disturbance inspections are only required during the rainy season from October 1st through April 30th.
