Airport Neighborhood Sewer

First project phase was constructed in 2014 and included installation of gravity sewer system along Kerr Avenue. County has developed improvement plans for second project phase. The second phase will include construction of new gravity sanitary sewer system which consists of approximately 20,000 feet of sewer pipe. The completed project will provide approximately 362 sewer service connections to the residents of the Airport Neighborhood Sewer District. Most of Project's construction is funded by the grant from California Water Board Department and additional funding is provided by the Community Development Block Grant. Construction for Project's second phase is tentatively scheduled to start February, 2017.
