

Intersections of Bradbury Road & S. Walnut Road and Central Avenue & Grayson Road

Stanislaus County proposes to install solar flashing beacons, electroliers, and widen shoulders at the T-intersection approach of Bradbury Road & S. Walnut Road and Central Avenue & Grayson Road. Roads at both intersections are two lanes rural county road. The intersection of Bradbury Road & S. Walnut Road is approximately three miles south of City of Turlock, and intersection of Central Avenue & Grayson Road is approximately two miles south of City of Ceres. The project is federally funded through Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP).

Construction work will include grading, placement of aggregate base material and asphalt concrete paving as well as overlay of existing pavement, installing electrolier at the intersections, installing solar flashing beacons, re-stripping and new signage. The shoulder widening is approximately two feet wide on all legs for about five hundred (500) feet in length at both T-intersections. The purpose of the project is to improve safety by providing lighting and increasing driver visibility as they approach the intersections. The project is currently under final design and will be in construction in the summer of 2017.
