## Keyes Road and Faith Home Road Intersection Signalization

The Keyes Road and Faith Home Road intersection is located in Stanislaus County, south of the City of Ceres and north of the City of Turlock. The project limits are from 0.25 mile east and west of Faith Home Road to 0.25 miles north and south of Keyes Road. The intersection is currently controlled by an all-way stop. The heavily used intersection has an average daily traffic count of 10,694 vehicles with a truck traffic percentage of 26.47%. Of 10,694 vehicles, 5,327 are going through the intersection during peak hours. The intersection currently has an overhead flashing beacon. The project, in general will consist of the installation of traffic signals and road widening to add left turn lanes in both directions along Faith Home Road. The purpose of the project is to improve air quality, reduce traffic delay, accommodate future traffic, improve safety and promote non-motorized modes of transportation on County roads.
