Mitchell Road will be rehabilitated from Yosemite Boulevard (SR 132) to the Tuolumne River Bridge. New striping, that includes a bike lane, will be included on both sides of the road. New and modified existing ADA compliant curb ramps will be installed at appropriate intersection crossings. Traffic signal modifications at Mitchell Road/Tenaya Avenue, Mitchell Road/S. Riverside Drive and Mitchell Road/Finch Road will also comply with current ADA standards. Rubberized hot mix asphalt (RHMA) will be used as the final overlay material. RHMA utilizes recycled passenger vehicle tires blended with the asphalt binder. This type of asphalt mix produces a longer lasting pavement when compared to conventional asphalt concrete.
