

Senior Luncheon



The senior lunch is *more than just a meal*, it's an opportunity to meet others and have some fun!

There are 9 lunch sites in Stanislaus County, usually held at senior or community centers. The Senior luncheon offer freshly made, healthy meals. These are high quality healthy meals – planned and approved by a Registered Dietitian.

COST: There is no fee for the meal, however a voluntary contribution of \$3.00 per meal is requested. Any amount helps fund more meals. Give what you can. No eligible participant will be denied a meal due to inability to contribute. *Open to seniors 60 or older & their spouse of any age.

(Guests under 60 are welcome but must pay the full cost of the meal, currently \$6)

Hours of Operation: Sites open early to encourage social activities and are generally open from 10:00-1:00 p.m. Meal service time varies site to site but generally is served between 11:30 and 12:00 noon.

***Eligibility Congregate Lunch Sites:** A spouse under 60, or a disabled dependent adult, that resides with and attends the lunch with an eligible senior is also eligible for the meal service.
