

Stanislaus County Senior Luncheon



The senior luncheon is ***more than just a meal***, it's an opportunity to meet others and have some fun!

The Senior luncheon offers freshly made healthy meals planned and approved by a Registered Dietitian.

COST: There is no fee for the meal however, we offer a voluntary contribution box and have a **\$4.00 per meal** suggested amount. No eligible participant will be denied a meal due to inability to contribute.

The Area Agency on Aging will protect the privacy and confidentiality of each recipient's contribution.

*Open to seniors 60 or older & their spouse of any age.

(Guests under 60 are welcome but **must pay the full cost of the meal**, currently \$7)

Note: Reservations are required. Please call the site you would like to attend **at least 1-2 days in advance when the site is open, before 12:00pm** to ensure your meal is prepared.

Hours of Operation: Sites open early for coffee & conversation. Usually 10:00-1:00 p.m. Meal service time varies by site but generally is served between 11:30am and 12:00 noon.

***Conditional eligibility:** A spouse under 60, or a disabled dependent adult, who resides with and attends the lunch with an eligible senior is eligible for the meal service

Meals on Wheels - Home Delivery

Meals on Wheels provides home delivered boxes of frozen meals for eligible homebound older adults.

Eligibility: To qualify for a home-delivered meal a person must be *60 years of age or older and be primarily home-bound due to physical or cognitive limitations. Those seniors that **live alone, are older & frail** are the highest priority for the home delivery service.

*Pick up "To-Go" meals from a local site may be another option.

*The Home Delivered meals are delivered by **TRIO Community Meals**. A box of 5 frozen entrees, bread & milk will be delivered **once a week**. Generally, Monday - Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.) depending on route assignment.

Note: *Newman Crows landing residents have fresh meals delivered weekdays, between 11:30am-12:30pm.

***Eligibility:** A spouse under 60, or a disabled dependent adult, that resides with an eligible senior may also be eligible for the meal service
