Note regarding subsidized senior housing:

There is often a long wait list for subsidized apartments, typically 1 to 2 years.

There are income and asset limits that must be recertified annually.

We recommend you apply to multiple places, so you have more options /choices and shorter wait time to obtain subsidized housing. You often must apply to each apartment complex.

Types of subsidized Housing:

"30%" = Tenant usually pays approximately 30% of their income based on their income, adjusted for assets, and certain expenses.

"Tiered" = Set reduced rent levels tenant qualified for based on income and assets. Private builders receive tax credits and have certain number of apartments dedicated for those at 30%, 40%, 45%, 50% even 60% of the median income for the area.

*Housing Authority Owned/Operated "Public Housing"

We list those that are senior only, disabled and or with only 1-bedroom. Family housing often also accept senior or single applicants. Contact Housing Authority for more information regarding family housing. Housing authority owned public housing is a separate application process (one list for all their senior housing) and different from Section 8.

SECTION 8 Voucher: Housing Authority voucher for adults & families that received Section 8 subsidy allows choice of where to live. The voucher can be used at any apartment /private home that has been approved for Section 8. Generally, tenant portion of rent about 30% of their income, adjusted for assets and certain expenses. Applications are only accepted periodically and wait period to receive benefit usually several years.

HUD VASH (Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing): Similar to the Section 8 Voucher but only for veterans -often more readily available than Section 8.

REACH (Relief for Energy Assistance through Community Help)

REACH is a program for low-income customers who cannot pay their Gas and Electric Company bill due to a sudden, unexpected financial hardship. It's a one-time payment through the Salvation Army with the help of donations from the utility's shareholders, employees and customers.

LIHEAP (Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program)

Low-income households may qualify for financial assistance with energy bills and weatherization projects through the Department of Health and Human Services. Here are examples of measures they may provide:

- Attic insulation, Door replacement, Door weather-stripping, Caulking, Minor home repair We may also replace the following appliances for qualified customers:
- Refrigerator, Room air conditioner, Evaporative coolers

Services for Medical Baseline and Life-Support Customers

(For Medical need (Medical Life Support) not income based.)

Residential customers dependent on life-support equipment and/or with special heating and cooling needs due to certain medical conditions may receive approximately 500 kilowatt hours (kwh) of electricity and/or 25 therms of gas per month, through PG & E. MID offers up to 50% off first 500 kilowatt hours. Application must be verified/signed by your physician.
