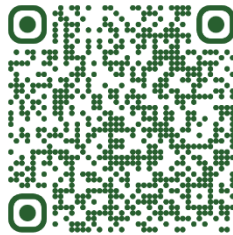
#### **Alcohol and Other Drug (AOD) Counselor Education Requirements**

Stanislaus County Behavioral Health & Recovery Services (BHRS) Quality Services, in collaboration with the Behavioral Health Plan (BHP) Division and Training Department, will be hosting two open office hours to provide any support to staff regarding upcoming changes to Alcohol or Other Drug (AOD) Counselor educational requirements reflected in [Behavioral Health Information Notice \(BHIN\) 25-029](#) and Assembly Bill (AB) 2473 that go into effect January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026. #### **Medi-Cal Informing Materials- 101**

Each month Quality Services will share information about one of the Medi-Cal Informing Materials required by the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) to be Medi-Cal compliant. These items are required to be present in any program that provides Specialty Mental Health (SMH) or Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Medi-Cal claimable services.

HIPAA Notice of Privacy Practices Poster - The HIPAA Privacy Notice is a notification that doctors and health plans must give patients. It tells people about their rights and how their private health information may be used or shared. This paper helps people understand how their health information is kept safe.
