Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Committee

Margie Johnson reported Jeff Mason from Center for Human Services provided a presentation on substance use disorder programs for children. In fiscal Year 2024-2025, services were provided to 78 unique youths, forty-five were served in schools and thirty-three were served in clinic-based programs.

PRESENTATION: BHRS Workforce Development and Training

Leonor Sierra, Chief of Integrated Services, and Amber Hayslett-Atkison, Manager provided a presentation on the Internship and Volunteer Programs. The goal is to connect with the community to develop a well-trained Mental Health workforce and to create career pathways through the Mental Health field with education and volunteer opportunities.
