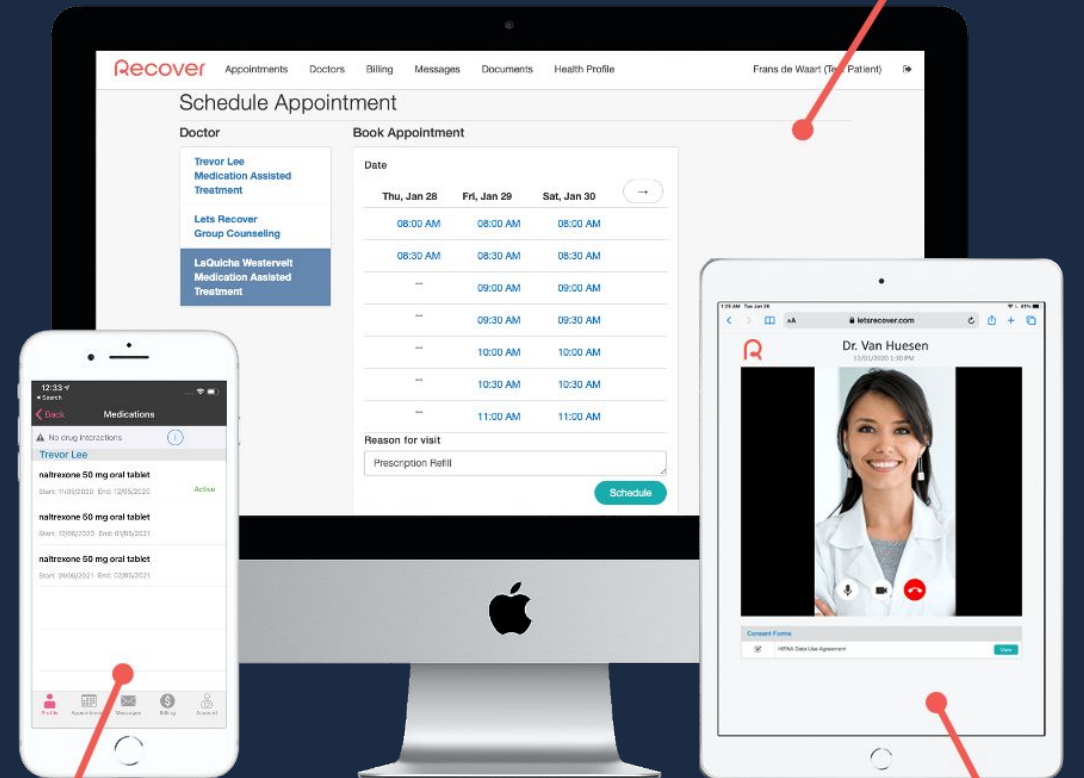

Medical care

All patients have access to:

- MAT
- Psychiatric care for mild to moderate co-occurring disorders



Counseling

- Our patients receive evidence-based counseling from experienced counselors
- Methodologies include CBT, MET, MI, and psychoeducational counseling



Case management

- Upon intake, all patients are assigned a dedicated case manager
- Case managers assist patients with medical assistance, educational and housing support, justice involvement, and other challenges


