

RE: UPDATE TO INTEGRATED MEMBER HANDBOOK FOR SPECIALITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES (SMHS) AND DRUG MEDI-CAL ORGANIZED DELIVERY SYSTEM (DMC-ODS)

Dear Member,

This notice is to inform you that there have been some significant changes and updates to the Stanislaus County Behavioral Health and Recovery Services – BHRS (hereinafter referred to as the Plan) Integrated Behavioral Health Member Handbook for SMHS and DMC-ODS. This integrated member handbook explains how to access SMHS and DMC-ODS services offered by the Plan and information regarding your rights and responsibilities as a member.

The significant changes reflected include the following types of new services such as, but not limited to:

- 1. Parent-Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT)
- 2. Functional Family Therapy (FFT)
- 3. Multisystemic Therapy (MST)
- 4. Assertive Community Treatment (ACT)
- 5. Forensic Assertive Community Treatment (FACT)
- 6. Coordinated Specialty Care (CSC) for First Episode Psychosis
- 7. Clubhouse Services
- 8. Enhanced Community Health Worker Services
- 9. Supported Employment
- 10. Traditional Health Care Practice
