This notice is to inform you that there have been some significant changes and updates to the Stanislaus County Behavioral Health and Recovery Services – BHRS (hereinafter referred to as the Plan) Integrated Behavioral Health Member Handbook for SMHS and DMC-ODS. This integrated member handbook explains how to access SMHS and DMC-ODS services offered by the Plan and information regarding your rights and responsibilities as a member.

The significant changes reflected include the following types of new services such as, but not limited to:

| 4. Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) | 9. Supported Employment |
| 5. Forensic Assertive Community Treatment (FACT) | 10. Traditional Health Care Practice |
