SUBJECT:

Approval to Authorize a Sales Order with CentralSquare Technologies, LLC in the Amount of \$84,600 for Additional Computer-Aided Dispatch Licenses for the Sheriff's Office

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

1. Approve the Sales Order with CentralSquare Technologies, LLC in the amount of \$84,600 for additional CAD licenses for the Sheriff's Office.
2. Authorize the General Services Agency (GSA) Director/Purchasing Agent, or designee, to execute the Sales Order with CentralSquare Technologies, LLC in the amount of \$84,600 for additional CAD licenses for the Sheriff's Office.

DISCUSSION:

There have been several updates on Sheriff dispatch services and implementation of an updated Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) presented to the Board of Supervisors over the last year. Please refer to the following Board meetings for additional background information:

- September 30, 2025 (Board Resolution 2025-0503)
- October 21, 2025 (Board Resolution 2025-0566)

At the March 11, 2025, meeting, the Board of Supervisors approved the purchase of licenses and related actions to ensure all County departments within Stanislaus Regional (SR) 911 would have access to the new CentralSquare system when the system is upgraded. The Sheriff's Office submitted the number of types and the number of licenses needed. Due to the total cost of the identified needs exceeding the authority granted, 250 mobile licenses were purchased to ensure the Department had enough licenses to support patrol deputies.

The Sheriff has expressed support for a new CAD system designed in partnership with Oracle. The Board of Supervisors approved various agreements with Oracle on May 23,

2023 (Board Resolution 2023-0246), to support development of a comprehensive software solution for CAD, as well as a new Jail Management System (JMS) and Records Management System (RMS).

The March 11, 2025, Board agenda item included authority for the Board Chairman to sign a letter to Sheriff Dirkse outlining the steps necessary to consider future alternatives to existing dispatch services. Discussion during the meeting included support for staff to explore the potential of a CAD-to-CAD solution within SR 911 that could facilitate the use of both CADs (CentralSquare and Oracle) working simultaneously through a technological interface. After further review, staff determined that a future CAD-to-CAD model would need to be accomplished in two phases.

The Sheriff expects development and implementation of the phase two Unify CAD-to-CAD interface no later than seven months after the “Go Live” date for the phase one CentralSquare CAD system. If the new system is not implemented within seven months, the Sheriff will request that the Board fully evaluate recommended options for alternative dispatch services. Any such options will adhere to the criteria set forth in the Board’s March 11, 2025, letter to the Sheriff.

This Board item includes the additional licenses needed to allow for the temporary use of CentralSquare CAD. The Sheriff’s Office will not be moving forward with any additional purchases that are not mandatory to get through the temporary solution. The Department does not anticipate requesting funds for Mobile Data Computers (MDC) to be replaced, as the procurement, receipt, and deployment of these computers will take as long as the temporary program. If the MDCs begin to fail, the Department will work through internal logistics until the transition to the Oracle tablet system is deployed.

POLICY ISSUE:

The County’s purchasing policy (Board Resolution No. 2025-0376) requires Board of Supervisors’ approval for contracts exceeding \$200,000 per contract year, and for multi-year contracts which exceed \$200,000 during the term of the contract. This requirement is based upon California Government Codes §25212, et seq, and §25502.5, et seq., which establish the powers of the Board of Supervisors and the Purchasing Agent.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The recommendations included in this report will authorize the GSA Director/Purchasing Agent to execute the sales order agreement with CentralSquare to purchase additional licenses for the Sheriff’s Office that were not included during the initial purchase. The annual cost for the eighteen CAD Workstation licenses is \$84,600. Patrol supervisors and managers, records, Contract Cities, and Threat Assessment Center staff will use these licenses. The Department does not anticipate this agreement to continue past the first year.

The licenses will be purchased through Information Technology Central and directly charged to the Sheriff’s Office. The impact of this request will be reviewed, and the Department may return, if necessary, to the Board of Supervisors at a future budget cycle to adjust the current year’s budget. The initial period for these licenses will be co-terminating with the existing licenses to ensure that all licenses renew on the same cycle.

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PRIORITY:

The recommended actions are consistent with the Board's priority of *Supporting a Strong and Safe Community* and *Delivering Efficient Public Services* by ensuring the Department has the technological resources needed to provide services to the community.

STAFFING IMPACT:

Existing County staff will execute the recommendations included in the report.

**SALES ORDER
PURSUANT TO EXISTING AGREEMENT**

This Sales Order is intended as a binding Agreement between Stanislaus County, California (“Customer”) and CentralSquare Technologies, LLC on behalf of itself and affiliates and subsidiaries including Superior, LLC; TriTech Software Systems; and CentralSquare Canada Software, Inc. (“CentralSquare”) and shall be effective as of the date of the last signature herein.

Quote Number: Q-240834 is attached to this Sales Order as Exhibit “A”. The Quote contains a description of all products and services sold pursuant to this Sales Order. The Quote is hereby incorporated by reference as a term of this Sales Order.

Payment Terms.

Software Licenses

100 % due on the Delivery Date*

Subscription

100 % due on the Delivery Date*

Third-Party

100 % due on the Effective Date of this Sales Order

*Delivery Date: For on-premise Solutions, Delivery shall be when CentralSquare delivers to Customer the initial copies of the Solutions outlined below in Exhibit A by whichever the following applies and occurs first (a) electronic delivery, by posting it on CentralSquare’s network for downloading, or similar suitable electronic file transfer method, or (b) physical shipment, such as on a disc or other suitable media transfer method, or (c) installation, or (d) delivery of managed services server. Physical shipment is on FOB - CentralSquare’s shipping point, and electronic delivery is at the time CentralSquare provides Customer with access to download the Solutions. For cloud-based Solutions Delivery shall be whichever the following applies and occurs first when Authorized Users have (a) received log-in access to the Solution or any module of the Solution or (b) received access to the Solution via a URL.

Subscription Access. If Customer is purchasing subscription software under this Sales Order, so long as Customer has paid the annual subscription fees and is current at all times with the subscription fees as stated herein, CentralSquare grants to Client a limited non-exclusive, non-transferable access to use the subscription software granted in this Sales Order. Customer understands and acknowledges no ownership or any form of intellectual property rights transfer under the terms of this Sales Order. Upon termination of this Sales Order or any subscriptions, (i) all rights granted herein shall terminate immediately and automatically upon the effective date of such termination; (ii) Customer’s right to the accessed software granted herein shall terminate; and (iii) Customer will cease using such software and at CentralSquare’s direction return or destroy the software and any supplemental confidential information or documentation. Customer shall maintain for a reasonable period, but in no event less than three (3) years after expiration or termination of this Sales Order, the systems, books and records necessary to accurately reflect compliance with software access and the use thereof. Upon request, and no more than once per year, Customer shall permit CentralSquare to audit Customer’s use of the software to monitor compliance. If an audit reveals that Customer has exceeded the restrictions on use or non-compliance with this Sales Order, Customer shall be responsible for the prompt payment by Customer to CentralSquare of any underpayment.

Payment due in full 30 days from date of invoice. Annual maintenance and Subscriptions renewals shall be due on the anniversary of the Delivery Date. Annual Maintenance and Subscription Fees are subject to increase as outlined in the Master Agreement.

Master Agreement. This Sales Order shall be governed by the terms and conditions of the existing Agreement between the parties (the “Master Agreement”). NO OTHER TERMS OR CONDITIONS OF THE MASTER AGREEMENT ARE NEGATED OR CHANGED AS A RESULT OF THIS DOCUMENT.


Purchase Order. Customer may provide CentralSquare with a valid purchase order, upon execution of this Sales Order.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein, purchase orders are to be used solely for Customer's accounting purposes and any terms and conditions contained therein shall be deemed null and void with respect to the parties' relationship and this Sales Order. Any such purchase order provided to CentralSquare shall in no way relieve Customer of any obligation entered into pursuant to this Sales Order including, but not limited to, its obligation to pay CentralSquare in a timely fashion.

Acceptance of Order Terms. By signing this Sales Order below, Customer represents and warrants that: (a) it has read and understands the Master Agreement and Quote that are incorporated by reference into this Sales Order and agrees to be bound by the terms thereof, and (b) it has full power and authority to accept this Sales Order.

Sheriff Dirkse:

This letter serves as a follow-up to the Board of Supervisors (Board) meeting on March 11, 2025. One of the topics discussed on March 11th was the potential implementation of a CAD-to-CAD solution within Stanislaus Regional 911 that would facilitate the use of the CentralSquare CAD system and Oracle CAD system working in tandem. In follow up to this meeting, staff determined the most viable option to pursue a CAD-to-CAD solution would be a two phased approach:

- Phase One: Implementation of the CentralSquare CAD system.
- Phase Two: Development and implementation of a new Unify CAD-to-CAD interface that will connect Oracle to CentralSquare.


This letter confirms the understanding of the Board and Sheriff that this project will move forward in two phases as recommended, with the Sheriff fully implementing CentralSquare as a first step in the process. The Sheriff also intends to deploy two Oracle modules during phase one: Records Management System (RMS) and Jail Management System (JMS).

Upon the completion of phase one (CentralSquare CAD/Oracle RMS and JMS "Go Live"), the Sheriff and Board will work together to develop and implement the new Unify CAD-to-CAD system within Stanislaus Regional 911. The implementation plan will identify all resources needed to fully implement the future CAD-to-CAD system and any financial and operational impacts going forward. Additional approvals of the Board of Supervisors and/or the Consolidated Emergency Dispatch Commission may be required based on the results of the planning process.

The Sheriff expects development and implementation of the phase two Unify CAD-to-CAD interface no later than seven months of the "Go Live" date for the phase one CentralSquare CAD system. If the new system is not implemented within seven months, the Board will, upon the Sheriff's request, fully evaluate recommended options for alternative dispatch services. Any such options will adhere to the criteria set forth in the Board's March 11, 2025, letter to the Sheriff. Further, nothing in this correspondence shall be construed as granting additional authority beyond those actions already approved by the Board of Supervisors or otherwise provided in County policy.

Thank you for your ongoing work to support public safety throughout our community.

CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION/LEVINE ACT DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

Government Code section 84308, part of the "Levine Act", prohibits County "Officers" from participating in any action related to a license, permit or other entitlement if such member receives political contributions totaling more than \$500 within the twelve months prior to the initiation of proceeding, during the pendency of the proceeding, and twelve months following the date of final decision on the entitlement. During the pendency of the proceeding and for twelve months following final decision on the entitlement, a "Party" or "Participant" as defined in section 84308, is prohibited from contributing more than \$500 to an "Officer".

Section 84308(a)(4) of the Levine Act defines an "officer" as follows: "Officer" means any elected or appointed officer of an agency, any alternate to an elected or appointed officer of an agency, and any candidate for elective office in an agency. The term "officer" is further defined 2 Cal. Code Regs. Section 18438.1, which states:

An officer of an agency includes only those persons who make, participate in making, or in any way attempt to use their official position to influence a decision in the license, permit, or entitlement for use proceeding, or who exercise authority or budgetary control over the agency of officers who may do so, and:

- (1) Serve in an elected position, including an official appointed to an elected position due to an interim vacancy or an election otherwise canceled because the official was the sole candidate for the position;
- (2) Serve as a member of a board or commission;
- (3) Serve as the chief executive of a state agency, or county, city or district of any kind; or
- (4) Have decision making authority with respect to the proceeding involving a license, permit, or other entitlement for use and is also a candidate for elected office or has been a candidate for elective office in the 12 months prior to the proceeding.


