Acceptance of the Report of Donations Received by the County of Stanislaus for the Third Quarter of Fiscal Year 2026

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

1. Accept the Report of Donations Received by the County of Stanislaus for the Third Quarter of Fiscal Year 2026.

DISCUSSION:

In accordance with Government Code Section 25355, the County Board of Supervisors has the authority to accept or reject any gift, bequest, or devise made to or in favor of the County and may delegate this authority to a designated officer. The Board delegated this authority to the Auditor-Controller on November 4, 2003, through Board Resolution No. 2003-1024. In keeping with the stipulations of Government Code Section 25355, the resolution requires the Auditor-Controller to report quarterly to the Board any donation received on behalf of the County valued in excess of \$10,000 along with the source of the donation.

For the third quarter of Fiscal Year 2026, covering the months of January, February, and March 2026, the County received the following three donations exceeding \$10,000.

1. Carnegie Corporation of New York contributed \$20,000 to support the Turlock and Newman libraries.
2. Stanislaus Library Foundation contributed \$53,650 to support various Library programs including the Summer Reading Challenge 2026, Dia de los Niños, Juvenile Justice Center Library Collection, and 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten.
3. Friends of Modesto Library contributed \$11,600 to support various Library programs including Modesto Summer Feeding and the Modesto Circulation budget.

A detailed report of donations received by the County for the third quarter of Fiscal Year 2026 is provided as Attachment 1.

POLICY ISSUE:

Government Code section 25355 and Board Resolution No. 2003-1024 requires the Auditor-Controller to report quarterly any donation valued in excess of \$10,000 received on behalf of the County and its source.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The donations accepted by the Auditor-Controller increased County revenues in the specified program areas.

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PRIORITY:

Acceptance of the Report of Donations Received by the County of Stanislaus will support the Board Priority of *Delivering Efficient Public Services* by providing information to the Board and the public on donations accepted on behalf of the County valued in excess of \$10,000.
