Welcome! The Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors (Board) welcomes your participation. This guide explains how to participate in today's meeting, find meeting information, and request assistance if needed.

Participate in Today's Meeting

- You may speak to the Board about any item on today's agenda when that item is called. You may also speak during Public Comment about County matters that are not on today's agenda. Speakers generally have five minutes, unless the Chairperson sets a different time limit. California law prohibits the Board from taking action on matters not on the posted agenda unless the matter is deemed by the Board to be an emergency. To participate in person or by phone, register beginning Friday evening after the agenda is posted and before Public Comment or before the agenda item you wish to address. Registration remains available throughout the meeting.
- Registration opens Friday evening after the agenda is posted and remains available throughout the meeting. Go to join.stancounty.com to register. There you will find access to the current meeting. Click the arrow on the right of the meeting title to launch the registration page.
- Complete the registration form by providing your
 - **Name**
 - **Phone number** (If you plan to participate by phone, please register using the same phone number you will use to call into the meeting. Matching your registration to your call helps staff quickly identify you and connect you when it is your turn to speak. If you use a different or invalid phone number, staff may be unable to identify your call, which could delay or prevent your opportunity to speak.)
 - **Email address** (Providing a valid email address allows the system to send a confirmation of your registration and important updates about the meeting. If you do not provide a valid email address, you will not receive these communications. Your email address is used only for Board meeting communications and will not be made available to the public.)

- **ZIP Code**
- Select whether you will participate **In Person or By Phone**
- Choose the agenda item(s) you wish to address or select Public Comment for matters not on the agenda; and,
- If needed, request a Spanish interpreter.
- **If Participating In Person**
 - Register online or in person the day of the meeting; optional - complete a Public Comment card the day of the meeting
 - Check in with staff when you arrive
 - When your name is called, come to the podium.
- **If Participating By Phone**
 - Pursuant to Government Code section 54953.4, as may be recodified or amended from time to time, the County shall make a good faith effort to provide two-way telephonic and/or internet-based access to meetings of the Board. In the event of a technological disruption, the County shall make reasonable efforts to restore access as promptly as practicable. If two-way access cannot be restored, the Board may, upon a majority vote, determine whether to proceed with the meeting and take action on agenda items, consistent with applicable law.
 - Go to join.stancounty.com to register.
 - On the day of the meeting, call **(209) 353-8391** using the instructions provided in your confirmation email. If you do not provide a valid email address during registration, you will not receive your confirmation email, meeting instructions, or other important updates.
 - Use the same phone number you entered during registration. See note above regarding the importance of using the same phone number.
 - The system will notify you when it is your turn to speak.

Submit Written Comments

- Email written comments to <mailto:cobsupport@stancounty.com> by 4:00 p.m. on the Monday before the meeting. Include the agenda item number or write Public Comment on the subject line. Written comments are shared with the Board and become part of the official meeting record.

Understand Today's Agenda - Most agenda sections include an opportunity for public comment before the Board takes action.

- **Consent Items** - Routine financial and administrative items are voted on together. To request discussion of a consent item, notify the Clerk before the meeting begins.
- **Public Hearings** - Items that require a public hearing by law. The Chairperson will open the hearing, invite public comment, close the hearing, and the Board will discuss and take action.
- **Discussion Items** - Items discussed and voted on individually.
- **Correspondence** - Letters, reports, and other communications received by the Board. The Board may receive and file correspondence or provide direction when appropriate.
- **Closed Session** - A private meeting allowed by law to discuss certain confidential matters specifically permitted by the Brown Act. The public may comment before the Board enters Closed Session.
