TERM: Committee members are appointed to indefinite terms and serve at the pleasure of

the Board of Supervisors.

DUTIES: The Committee functions to develop & implement the Comprehensive Economic

Development Strategy for Stanislaus County and its nine incorporated cities. The Committee serves as a liaison between member jurisdictions and the programs offered by the Economic Development Administration that promote permanent

employment and economic growth.

MEETINGS: Meetings are held as needed, with a minimum of 2 meetings annually. Special
