4 Representatives of Supervisorial Districts (1 per district for the districts not represented by the Board of Supervisors representative) 7
Community Representatives

Composition should include some combination of representatives of local governments, business, industry, finance, agriculture, the professions, organized labor, utilities, education, community organizations, public health agencies, the unemployed, ethnic minorities, and women. Committee members should also possess knowledge of the business and economic situation of Stanislaus County.

TERM: Committee members are appointed to indefinite terms and serve at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors.

DUTIES: The Committee functions to develop & implement the Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy for Stanislaus County and its nine incorporated cities. The Committee serves as a liaison between member jurisdictions and the programs offered by the Economic Development Administration that promote permanent employment and economic growth.

MEETINGS: Meetings are held as needed, with a minimum of 2 meetings annually. Special meetings will also be held as needed. Meeting locations shall be stated on the agenda.
