Regular Session All Supervisors Present Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag Tuesday

February 23, 2021

Invocation was given by Pastor Scott Stubbert from Big Valley Grace Church.

A moment of silence was held for former City of Modesto Mayor Carol Whiteside.

Public Health Officer Dr. Vaishampayan, Deputy Fire Warden Erik Klevmyr and CEO Hayes provided an update related to the 2019 Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) emergency and essential services in Stanislaus County.

Chairman Chiesa acknowledged receipt of written public comments. He noted that all public comments submitted via email were distributed to the members of the Board of Supervisors.

Miguel Donoso voiced concerns that today's COVID-19 update did not include information regarding race and ethnicity.

John X. Mataka, from the Latino COVID-19 Coalition and the Grayson Neighborhood Council, spoke regarding the California Rural Legal Assistance's report concerning the distribution of the County's Small Business Grants and which communities were overrepresented or underrepresented. He recommended that we receive outcomes from the businesses that received grants, and a report regarding the businesses that were not funded and why, and the total number applicants that applied for business grants. He asked whether the City of Modesto received funding and if more outreach has been done in Modesto than in other locations. He also spoke regarding an ethnicity and racial component for all COVID-19 funding, and if there are instruments in place to measure these results. He voiced concerns regarding the duplicate funding in the business grant program and noted that they do not want to see this issue with the rental assistance program. He thanked the Board for taking a moment of silence for former Modesto Mayor Carol Whiteside.

Debra Harper thanked the County for the COVID-19 update and for all the County's efforts in addressing the pandemic. She welcomed the new Supervisors to the Board, and spoke regarding her frustration with her process in applying for State disability.
