No public comments were made.

The Board received updates from the Chief Executive Office regarding the Board of Supervisors' priority areas and charting the future direction. Areas of discussion included: Board office staffing; a new County mission statement that will be rolled out later this year; the Commercial Cannabis Program; Focus on Prevention; Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act funding; Master Property Tax Agreements; and the Community Development Fund.

Supervisor Withrow spoke regarding the need for a Salida substation. He requested that staff analyze Property Assessment Clean Energy (PACE) programs for commercial properties.

Supervisor B. Condit spoke regarding the Education Revenue and Augmentation Fund and the impact on fire districts.

Supervisor C. Condit spoke regarding creating a Youth Commission. He also would like the County to recognize the Veteran of the Year, Business of the Year, and Woman of the Year.

Supervisor Grewal spoke regarding the infrastructure for County unincorporated islands, and the need for clean-up of homeless encampments. He would like to see the Salida Fire Station on Ladd Road reopened.

Chairman Chiesa spoke regarding the need for more migrant housing and cold weather housing for the homeless. He also spoke regarding the extra space at Juvenile Hall, the closure of Turlock Lake State Park, and noted that he wants the State to consider large cannabis grows a felony.
