Ruben Imperial, Director of Behavioral Health and Recovery Services, provided an update on May as Behavioral Health Month.

Ron McMurtry voiced concerns regarding comments made at a Board meeting earlier this year regarding COVID, SARS-COV-2, vaccines, and autism.

Perfecto Munoz, with the West Modesto Community Collaborative, spoke regarding the resources the organization provides and the Impact Report he distributed to the Board members last month. Withdraw/Grewal unan. **7.1** Approved the filing of a Notice of Exemption finding that approval of the 2025-2029 Consolidated Plan (Con Plan) and the 2025 Annual Action Plan (AAP) are Exempt under provisions of the CEQA pursuant to State Guidelines; approved the Con Plan for the Stanislaus Urban County and the Stanislaus HOME Consortium submittal to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); approved the AAP for the Stanislaus Urban County and the Stanislaus HOME Consortium for submittal to HUD; authorized the proportional adjustment of estimated allocation amounts identified in the AAP to reflect HUD's actual 2025 Program Year funding allocation; authorized the Director of Planning and Community Development to sign and submit to HUD the Applications for Federal Assistance (SF-424, SF-424B and SF-424D), and Community Development Block Grant

Supervisor C. Condit provided an update on the continued efforts to assist Diablo Grande residents during the community’s water crisis.

Supervisor Chiesa reported that he attended last night’s Hughson City Council meeting, where Bob Bettencourt was honored for his 50 years of volunteer service with the Hughson Fire Protection District. He also noted the Board members attended a Board Workshop last week and emphasized the importance of these meetings.

Chairman B. Condit thanked Stanislaus Consolidated Fire Protection District Station 26 for hosting the Board Workshop and providing a tour and demonstration.

CEO Hayes provided an update that the Governor’s Office will release the May Revised Budget this Wednesday, 5/14/2025. He reported that significant state level deficits are expected, which could impact local government. He also noted that several key committee meetings are taking place at the federal level this week. He shared that the County is on budget watch this week at both the state and federal levels.

Prior to adjourning into Closed Session an opportunity was given to the public to address matters listed under Closed Session.
