A moment of silence was held for former Stanislaus County employees, Nancy Bronstein and Carla Zepeda.

Invocation was given by Pastor Lonnie Skiles with Big Valley Grace Community Church.

Maria Solis and Rosa Soto from BHRS, Narjes Zare from CSA and Tera Chumley from Parks received their 25-year Employee Service Award; and, Magda Garibay from CSA received her 30-year Employee Service Award.

The Board recognized the 2026 Employee Mentors.

Tera Chumley, Director of Parks and Recreation gave a presentation for July 2026 as Parks and Recreation Month in Stanislaus County.

Ron McMurtry shared concerns regarding the connection between illegal food vendors and human trafficking.

Bryan Evitt voiced concerns regarding the County's zoning.

David Hicks, a Denair resident, shared a handout with Board members and voiced concerns regarding sidewalk obstacles that force him to push his daughter, who uses a wheelchair, into the street, creating safety risks.
