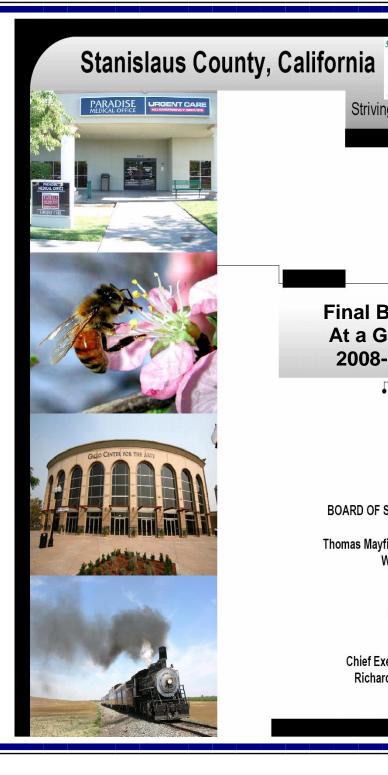

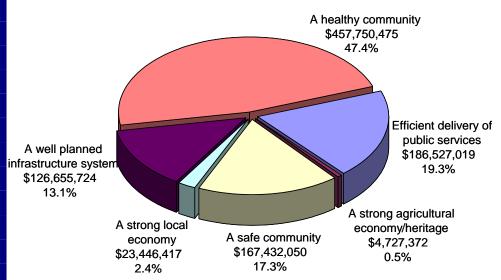

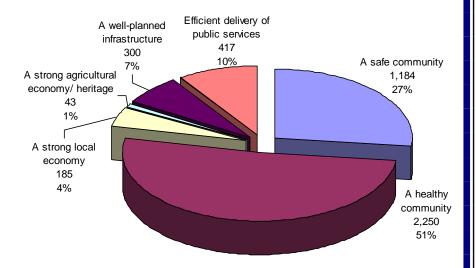

Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Final Budget Appropriations by Board Priority

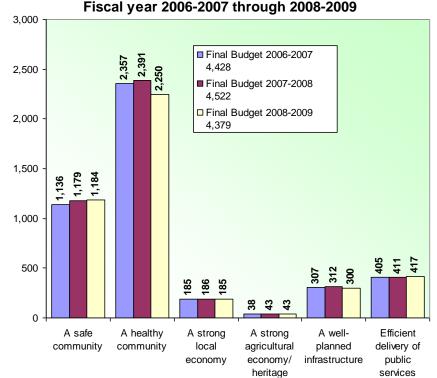

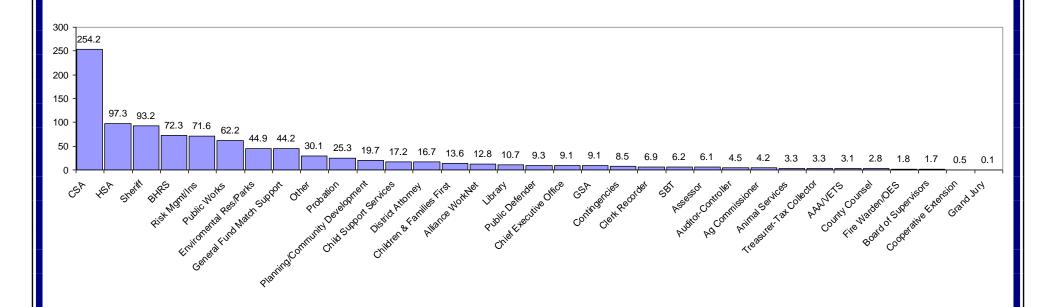
Total Staffing by Board Priority Final Budget 2008-2009



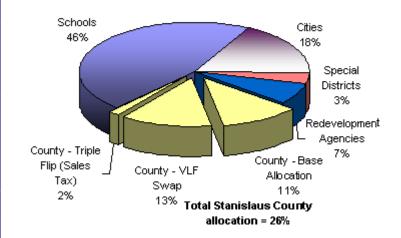
Total Staffing by Board Priority Fiscal year 2006-2007 through 2008-2009



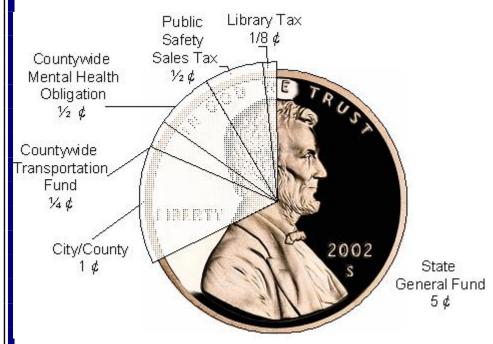




Where Your Property Tax Goes (Rounded)

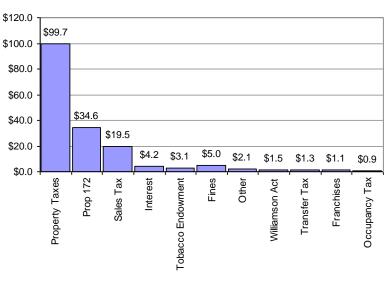


Where Your Sales Tax Goes
