WHEREAS, it appears that the best interests of the people of Stanislaus County would be best served by the formation of a Committee to investigate and develop solutions to problems faced in this area, composed of representatives of each of the cities in Stanislaus County, representatives and experts in the farm interests, and of representatives of business interests;

NOW, THEREFORE, upon motion of Supervisor Brink, seconded by Supervisor Franzen, it is ordered by unanimous vote of this Board that the "Economic Development Action Committee" be and hereby is duly established; and that Supervisor Ruggieri be, and hereby is, appointed Chairman of said Committee; and that the aims of said Committee shall be to improve the economic climate of Stanislaus County in an advisory capacity to the Board of Supervisors; and shall consist of not less than ten (10) members; and that further hearing is continued to April 24, 1962, for nomination of members of said committee, and appointment thereof.
