Marcus Griffin and Brendan Quinn spoke on behalf of the project, which will consist of 261 total units, 259 being affordable housing units, and 2 manager units. The project will be

located at the intersection of Geer Road and Christofferson Parkway, across from CSU, Stanislaus, and is close to many amenities and public transit. Geer Family Apartments was approved by the City of Turlock January 2023.

30 units will qualify as very-low income units (rents less than 50% of the Area Median Income), with the remaining units qualifying as low income units (rents between 50 - 80% of the Area Median Income). Redevelopment and Home Funds may also be available for this project.

Pursuant to the Stanislaus County Public Facilities Fees Administrative Guidelines, Section III.E.1, this project would qualify for Affordable Housing PFF deferrals/waivers, based on income eligibility. Member Leamon motioned to approve the request for PFF deferrals/waivers, based on eligibility guidelines.

To Whom it May Concern,

Please take notice of this request for appeal of the fees associated with building permit 2022-00001573 that was paid on 8/29/23 in the amount of \$73,170.94.

On September 29, 2023, a formal appeal was filed with the City of Turlock due to the impact and development fees and road fees included in the permit. On December 4, 2023, Valley Milk met with the City of Turlock officials to review the appeal and was informed that an additional appeal was required to dispute the county fees included in the building permit.

As a result of this project for which the permit was filed, Valley Milk will be reducing the outbound freight traffic by 2 trucks/day or 50% of the outbound freight for cream trucks. Additionally, Valley Milk will be reducing the amount of inbound milk tankers to the plant by 2 trucks/day. This is a reduction in the traffic on the road, making the city of Turlock more sustainable, reduces carbon emissions and reduces the potential for traffic accidents. From a growth standpoint, this new addition will bring in additional employees who will work one shift per day and require two operators per shift. This will add two passenger vehicles to the road daily. There is no justification for Valley Milk to pay \$21,471 in roads, transportation, and infrastructure fees when we are reducing the impact on the roads, city, and county. We respectfully request that the RTIF be eliminated from the permit fees.

I look forward to your prompt response regarding this issue.

Background and Pricing Proposal:

The Stanislaus County Planning and Community Development Department's Building Permits Services is assigned to oversee the County's One-Stop-Shop permitting process. That assignment includes overseeing the calculation and collection of County Public Facilities Fees (PFF) for development within the unincorporated area; including working with staff from the nine cities and the County Auditor Office on the calculation and collection of PFF for development within the cities. The PFF efforts undertaken by Building Permit Services (collections, deferrals, releases, record retention, and general documentation) are all supported by five (5) staff members dependent on the use of permitting software.

On September 13, 2011, the Board of Supervisors approved the purchase of the Accela Software for the One-Stop-Shop permitting process and the software was implemented and placed into full usage in 2012. Since 2012, Building Permit Services has collected over \$47,880,000 in PFF for development in the unincorporated area and, as of January 1, 2024, maintains 25,820 PFF cases within the Accela Software system.

The 2011 authorization to purchase the Accela Software included use of \$266,909 from the PFF Administration Account. On March 18, 2010, the PFF committee (committee) approved a methodology substantiating a proportional share of costs associated for the purchase of the Accela Software to assist in the administration of the PFF program. A percentage was established by comparing the number of PFF cases to building permit cases within the permitting system in use at that time. Based on a determined split of 41% to 59% (PFF cases to building permits cases), the committee approved the allocation of PFF for the purchase and implementation of the Accela Software and the hardware infrastructure required to host the system. The total approved cost, with contingency, in 2011 was \$650,998, with PFF covering 41% (\$266,909) of the cost and the remaining 59% (\$384,089) covered by the department's Building Permit Services fund balance. The County's purchase of the Accela Software included licenses for an unlimited number of users. Current users include staff from various County departments (Assessors, Auditors, CEO's, Environmental Resources, Fire Warden, Planning, and Public Works) and the City of Ceres' Planning Department which contracts with the department for building permit plan check and inspection services. In addition to PFF and building permits, the Accela Software system is used by Public Works for grading and encroachment permits and by the County Fire Warden for annual inspections, school inspections, and fire life safety compliance.

While the Accela Software is utilized for more than just building permits, from Fiscal Year 2012/2013 to present, Building Permits Services has expended over \$900,000 to purchase the annual licensing packages, maintenance upgrades, and server systems with minimal cost recover from other users. Beyond the original purchase, no PFF funds have been used in maintaining and upgrading the Accela Software.

The current Accela Software is an "on-premise" system which means that it is installed and operated from the County's in-housing server and computing infrastructure. Due to increases in costs associated with server maintenance, the department began exploring options to transition to the Accela "cloud" system, which is remotely hosted, in late 2022. At that time, Accela indicated that it was unknown when the company would be switching to a cloud only offering (meaning no further support for on-premise systems); however, by August 2023, Accela had placed the department on notice that of their decision to discontinue maintenance of the "on-premise" system on June 30, 2025. A cloud-based system comes with a more specific "per user" licensing contract which is more expensive, however, it also eliminates the cost

of on-premise servers, on call consultant services, and constant work disruptions due to server malfunctions.

Accela has provided a pricing proposal for the on-premise to the cloud migration which include 3-, 5-, and 10-year contracting options. The longer 5- and 10- year contract options provide for a greater cost reduction opportunity if the first two years are paid upfront. The pricing proposal was based on 70 user licenses, enough to cover all 66 users and to allow for some growth in the number of users. The option providing an overall savings of \$327,000, over the life of the contract, is the 10-year contract term with two years paid upfront. Under this option, with the year one to year ten costs ranging from \$177,100 to \$274,740, the two-year upfront cost is \$363,055. In addition to the annual costs, the pricing proposal includes a one-time cost of \$60,000 for Accela's implementation of the migration and a one-time cost of \$15,000 for use of the departments third-party consultant to assist with the migration. The total cost of the 10-year contract, with the two-year upfront payment and the one-time migration costs, is \$2,287,544.

PFF Administrative Funding Request:

The department is requesting committee approval to utilize PFF Administrative Funding to cover a portion of the one-time migration costs and the two-year upfront license costs for a new Accela Cloud Permitting System. Currently the ratio of PFF to building permit cases is 1:5; reflecting a 20% to 80% split in overall case numbers:

Utilizing the 20/80 split, the PFF Administrative Funds would be used to cover \$87,600 of the costs with the remaining \$350,400 in costs covered by the department:

CLOUD MIGRATION, IMPLEMENTATION, AND UPFRONT COSTS

In addition to the \$80,000, the department is requesting committee approval to utilize PFF Administrative Funds to cover on-going licensing costs directly associated with the administration of the County's PFF program by the department. The year-one PFF cost is estimated to be \$4,774.50 based on the percentage of time the five (5) Building Permit Services staff members spend directly working on PFF cases:

If the committee approves the above on-going licensing costs, the department will bill those costs annually as part of its routine billing for staff time spent administering the PFF program.
