- 4. The subsequent project is within the scope of the project covered by the Master EIRs.

- 6. No substantial changes have occurred with respect to the circumstances under which the Master EIRs were certified, and no new information, which was not known and could not have been known at the time that the Master EIRs were certified as complete, has become available.
