Project Title: Proposed Amendments to District Rule 4905 (Natural Gas-fired, Fan-Type Central Furnaces)

Project Location (Specific): Not Applicable

Project Location (City): All cities within the San Joaquin Valley Air Basin (SJVAB)

Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project: The District is proposing to amend District Rule 4905 (Natural Gas-fired, Fan-Type Central Furnaces) to allow the District to extend the emissions fee option period for weatherized units. This will allow an additional period of time to continue technology development and certification while providing strong incentive for accelerated deployment of compliant units. The new extended end date will be September 30, 2021. There is no changes in the fee structure.


