Did you know 11 years ago, in 2014, California passed the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) to manage groundwater use at the local level to ensure long-term sustainability? To support small-scale farmers in understanding and complying with SGMA, UC ANR offers technical assistance. This is part of the Underrepresented Communities, California Tribes, and Small Farmers Groundwater Technical Assistance Program (URCTA) funded by the California Department of Water Resources (CA DWR). The technical assistance includes-

- Education on SGMA rules and regulations
- Outreach including farm visits, workshops and one on one assistance
- Needs Assessment
- Well, pump, soil, and aquifer testing
- Referral to other available support
