## Free Disposal for Stanislaus County Residents

Open to Stanislaus household residents on Fridays & Saturdays 8AM - 12PM

- Household waste does not belong in the **TRASH** or down the **STORM DRAIN**!
- Daily Maximum of up to 15 Gallons or 125 pounds of combined weight.

No container over 5 Gallon per H&SC 25218.5.1

Small businesses may be eligible to dispose of waste pending approval. Waste will ONLY be accepted by calling 209-525-6700 for an appointment.

### Things to know before arriving:

#### For your Safety

- Remain in your vehicle at all times
- Keep all WASTE in your trunk or near the end of the tailgate
- All Material must be VISIBLE upon arrival
- Do not pack items in sealed boxes or bags

Staff WILL NOT, climb into bed of truck or enter your vehicle to sort through waste.

Leaving hazardous materials at the Facility before, after, or when operator is not present is considered illegal dumping!

- Keyboards & Mouses
- Cell-phones and Tablets
- TV Monitors (CRT & NON-CRT)
- Gaming Systems
- Internet Modems & Routers
- DVD & VCR Players
- Radios, Stereos, Speakers, Amplifiers
- Printers, scanners, fax machines (Home use, **up to 2**)
- Home use Batteries (**1qt per day in clear bag/container, please tape button batteries before arrival**)
- Fluorescent Tubes (Home use only, **up to 10**)
- Wires (cords, Christmas lights, computer cables, and more).



### Items we DO NOT ACCEPT:

## Hazardous Waste we **ACCEPT**:

### Items should never be mixed together

Daily Maximum of up to 15 Gallons or 125 pounds of combined weight.

- AntiFreeze
- Car Batteries (Lead Acid)
- Brake Fluid
- Carburetor Cleaner
- Gasoline/Diesel Fuel
- Road Flares
- Used Oil & Oil Filters



- Roof Tar
- Herbicides
- Pesticides
- Kerosene
- Aerosol Products
- Drain Cleaners



- Paint & Paint thinner (new & used)
- Mercury devices (thermostats & thermometers)
- Charcoal lighter fluid & Tiki Oil
- Caulking & adhesives
- Degreasers and rust removers

## Hazardous Waste we **DO NOT ACCEPT**:

The following waste will not be taken at the facility or mobile events:

No container over 5 Gallon per H&SC 25218.5.1

- Ammunition
- Asbestos
- Commercial Ag Chemicals
- Cooking oil
- Dried Paint
- Explosives
- Hard Concrete
- Marine Flares
- Pharmaceutical Waste (including chemotherapy medication or vitamins)
- Propane Cylinders larger than 5 gallons
- Cylinders with Oxygen, Helium, Argon, etc.
- Tires
- Balloon Tanks (Helium tanks)
- Radioactive waste
- Waste in containers over 5 gal.
- Loads greater than 125lbs
- Empty containers

## Home - Generated Sharps Accepted

Only home generated sharps will be accepted (**no businesses**)

- **Do not mix medications with sharps.**
- Sharps must be stored in a rigid container **with closed lid** (no bags)
- Containers must be rigid plastic or metal, sealed, leak proof, and **not easily reponed upon arrival**
- **NO GLASS or CARDBOARD** containers will be accepted
- Examples of acceptable containers include: empty soda bottles, coffee cans, juice or milk bottles, laundry bottles, etc.
- Some companies sell containers and provide mail back services for sharps.





Many household hazardous products like oven cleaners, paint removers, bug killers, solvents, and drain cleaners contain potentially harmful chemicals to both people and the environment. Proper disposal is crucial; these products must never be poured onto the ground, into gutters, or down storm drains. Everything that enters storm drains goes directly to our rivers and streams, eventually affecting our fishing, drinking, and swimming water. Stormwater pollution is the biggest source of water pollution.
