Please join our staff to discuss the proposed adjustments to the fee schedule. This includes adjustments related to the Department's Weighted Labor Rate, as well as, new and amended or elimination of existing fees related to:

- **3.5% charge added to any fee collected by credit card**
- **Hazardous Materials - Underground Storage Tank, Farm Disclosure and Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator fees**
- **Environmental Health – Temporary Food Facilities and Mobile Food Facility Plan fees, Well Construction Program fees, Septic Pumper Truck fees, Liquid Waste Program fees, and Administrative fees, as well as, a new Organized Camp fee categories, and eliminating some fee categories**
- **Landfill - Ash Tipping and Appliance (white goods waste) fees**

If the fees are approved, they will become effective 30 days after passage, on June 24, 2021, with the exception of changes to any Landfill fees which would become effective on July 1, 2021.
