**Please join our staff to discuss the proposed adjustments to the fee schedule. This includes new and amended or elimination of existing fees related to:**

- **Department's Weighted Labor Rate**
- **Hazardous Materials - Underground Storage Tank, Hazardous Materials Business Plan Program**
- **Environmental Health – Recreational Health, Body Art, Water Program, Liquid Waste Program, Land Use, and Well Construction**
- **Landfill - Ash Tipping and Disposal fees**
- **Groundwater Resources – Groundwater Ordinance Plan Review**

**If the fees are approved, they will become effective 30 days after passage, on June 23, 2022, with the exception of changes to any Landfill fees which would become effective on July 1, 2022.**
