## WORKSHOP FOR PROPOSED FEES

**Thursday, March 23, 2023 from 9:00 AM – 10:00 AM and 5:00 PM – 6:00 PM**

This notice is an invitation to attend a public meeting to discuss proposed new and amended or elimination of existing fees to the Stanislaus County Master Schedule of Fees for the Department of Environmental Resources (DER). The mission of DER is to promote a safe and healthy environment and improve the quality of life in our community. DER recognizes that the collaboration, input and expertise of the business community is valuable to ensure we accomplish this goal.

You are invited to join our staff to discuss the proposed adjustments to the fee schedule. The Department will address the basis for the proposed changes and there will be an opportunity to ask questions. This includes new and amended or elimination of existing fees related to:

- Weighted Labor Rate
- Hazardous Materials - Underground Storage Tank Program, Aboveground Petroleum Storage Act Program, and California Electronic Reporting System
- Environmental Health – Food Program, Body Art, Recreational Health, Well Construction, Water Program, and Land Use
- Milk and Dairy – Grade A and B, including Other Hooved Mammals, quarterly fees
- Solid Waste –Small Hauler Annual Permit Fee, Small Hauler Annual Truck Fee
- Landfill - Ash Tipping and Disposal fees

This workshop is being conducted prior to the Board of Supervisors' approval of the fee proposals. The proposed fee adjustments will be available online by the date of the workshop, at <http://www.stancounty.com/er/>. Please let us know if you would like a copy emailed or mailed to you. If the fees are approved, they will become effective on June 22, 2023, with the exception of changes to any Landfill fees which would become effective on July 1, 2023.
