STANISLAUS COUNTY SEEKS APPLICANTS FOR FARMWORKER ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Application Deadline: July 15, 2025

Stanislaus County, Calif. – Stanislaus County is now accepting applications for its newly established Farmworker Advisory Committee (FAC). The committee will include ten farmworkers—two from each [supervisory district](#)—and one representative each from the following stakeholder groups: the Agriculture Industry, a Farm Labor Contractor, the Stanislaus County Agricultural Advisory Board, and a community-based organization serving the County's farmworker population.

Applications are available in both [English](#) and [Spanish](#), and the deadline to apply is July 15, 2025.

The FAC will serve as a forum to elevate the voices of farmworkers and provide insight into the challenges they face, including issues related to housing, access to safety-net services, health, working conditions, and immigration.

The Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors approved the formation of the committee as a one-year pilot project on [November 12, 2024](#). Each committee member will receive a \$100 stipend per meeting, for up to six meetings per year.
