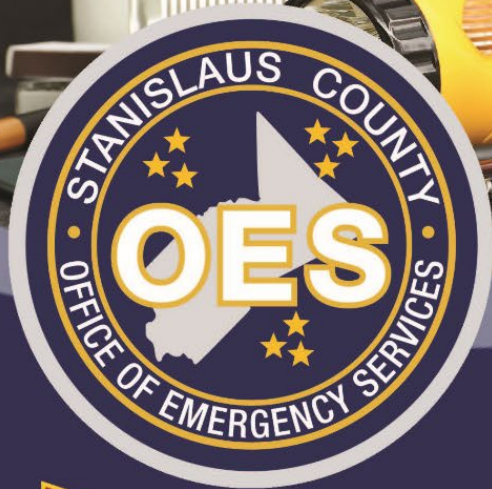
Helicopter and emergency response equipment on display, first responder safety demonstrations, participating public safety agencies, and families taking part in emergency preparedness activities.
