What is the PIT Count?

The Point-in-Time (PIT) Count is a one-day, unduplicated count of individuals and families experiencing homelessness.

Understanding who is experiencing homelessness helps define the problem and its causes. The data helps us to design more effective policies and programs, as well as measure progress towards reducing homelessness.

Volunteers are needed county-wide to conduct surveys using a smartphone application and distribute care kits.
