To implement the policies established by the Board of Supervisors pertaining to parks, which includes acquiring, developing, and maintaining recreation areas serving every segment of society,




including the disabled and economically disadvantaged. To provide the leadership necessary to develop and manage parks and recreation facilities in ways that will provide the best possible experience for people to enjoy the outdoors at the most reasonable costs.

WHO WE ARE:

The Department of Parks and Recreation encompasses over 6,000 acres of parks and open space and maintains five regional parks, 12 neighborhood parks, 10 community parks, two off-highway vehicle parks, four cemeteries, two bridges, La Grange historical areas, five fishing access points along rivers and lakes, one swimming pool, one organized youth camp, numerous acres of open space and river bottom, including landscape/ground maintenance services and streetscape maintenance for various county services areas, county centers, libraries, landscape maintenance districts, and other governmental buildings in the unincorporated areas of the County. These facilities provide a vast array of recreational opportunities including, but not limited to, picnicking, sailing, power boating, water skiing, jet skiing, fishing, swimming, camping, hiking, hunting, and horseback and biking trails.

Led by Director Jami Aggers, the Department consists of three divisions: Administration, Community Parks/ Centers, and Regional Parks. It is comprised of approximately 42 full-time employees, including an Assistant Director, three Parks Managers, a Parks Supervisor, Marketing Coordinator, Grant Writer, Project Coordinator and dedicated support staff who maintain the grounds and operations of identified parks and facilities at the current level of service, evaluate priorities and adjust the workforce to the priorities identified to efficiently carry out the mission, and provide basic levels of services at all general funded neighborhood parks, cemeteries, bridges, County facilities and office buildings, reservoirs, and regional parks throughout Stanislaus County.

COUNTY CENTERS & COMMUNITY PARKS

The Parks Department operates 22 parks officially categorized as Neighborhood Parks. These parks range from less than one quarter acre to over 50 acres each. Neighborhood Parks total 106.21 acres, which is less than 2% the total parks acreage owned and operated by the County. However, these are some of the most visible park assets in the County and provide local recreational opportunities for many unincorporated communities within the County which do not otherwise have community parks facilities.

The Department also provides landscaping services to the following County Centers:

Stanislaus County Library – 11 sites throughout the County, including Modesto, Ceres, Denair, Empire, Oakdale, Patterson, Riverbank, Salida, Turlock, Waterford and Newman.

Laird Regional Park consists of 97 acres of land, 30 of which have been developed so far for recreational purposes and are open to the public. It is located on Grayson Road (J16) about two miles east of the community of Grayson on the San Joaquin River. This park also serves the role of neighborhood park to the nearby communities, featuring picnic facilities, group areas, playing fields, and a large event shelter that is able to be reserved for family reunions, weddings, and parties.





Frank Raines Regional Park offers the rugged slopes of California's Coast Range and is divided functionally into three units, separated by several miles of road. The Minniear Area encompasses over 1,000 acres of undeveloped land designed for nonmotorized recreation use. The Frank Raines Day Use Area provides picnic tables, barbecues, a themed playground, and more. And for campers and OHV enthusiasts, the Frank Raines Off-Highway Vehicle Park is located across from the Day Use Area.

2018 IMPROVEMENTS & ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- A Back up Generator was obtained to provide electricity during power outages for campsites, the waste water system, water treatment plant, recreation hall, RV pedestals, and restrooms

- Off-Highway Vehicle Restoration Grant was awarded to temporarily close and restore sections of the Park which are in need of repair due to OHV riding/use







Parks Master Plan was completed and approved in May 2018 by the Board of Supervisors. Projects are being identified for funding as State grants are made available from Proposition 68. Applications will be submitted in 2019 for competitive review, and priority is given to criteria based on underserved areas with consideration given to the Parks Master Plan and other pertinent current grant guidelines.


