The remaining "Consent" items for which there are no voice objections will be handled by a single action of the Commission.

ANY MEMBER OF THE AUDIENCE DESIRING TO ADDRESS THE PLANNING COMMISSION REGARDING A MATTER ON THE AGENDA: While the Planning Commission welcomes and encourages participation in the Commission meetings, it would be appreciated if comments are limited to five minutes so that everyone may be heard.

Any member of the public wishing to address the Commission during the "Citizen's Forum" period will be limited to a maximum of 5 minutes.

New agenda items will not be heard after 11:00 p.m. If agenda item is not fully discussed by 12:30 a.m., it will be continued at the discretion of the Chair.

PLN2014-0023 - VERIZON WIRELESS - E.</u> <u>HAWKEYE AVE</u> – *Requesting continuance to March 5, 2015.* Request to install a new wireless communication facility consisting of a 110' high stealth monopole with a 204 square foot equipment shelter at its base and nine (9) mounted antennas on a 17.13± acre parcel in the A-2-40 (General Agriculture) zoning district. The property is located at 27107 Highway 33, on the southwest corner of Stuhr Road and Highway 33, just north of the city limits of Newman, in the City of Newman Sphere of Influence. PLN2014-</u> <u>0080 - SALIDA MARKET</u> – Request to amend the General Plan designation of Medium Density Residential to Planned Development and rezone from C-2 (General Commercial) to P-D (Planned Development) on a .33± acre parcel in order to replace a 4,406 square foot building with an 8,761 square foot building to be used as a retail market. The property is located at 4600 Broadway Avenue, at the south corner of the Broadway Avenue and Curtis Street intersection, in the Downtown Salida area. The proposed rezone will facilitate the project's ability to meet parking requirements and allow additional lot coverage.
