Stanislaus Urban County and Stanislaus HOME Consortium

Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report Fiscal Year 2025-2026

Stanislaus County, in partnership with the cities of Ceres, Hughson, Newman, Oakdale, Patterson, Riverbank, and Waterford, form the Stanislaus Urban County for the purpose of receiving funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) programs. The Stanislaus Urban County also partners with the City of Turlock to form the Stanislaus HOME Consortium, which receives HUD HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) funding. Stanislaus County is the lead entity for both the Urban County and the HOME Consortium responsible for administering these funds.

The Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) will address the outcomes and expenditure of HUD entitlement funds allocated to Stanislaus Urban County and Stanislaus HOME Consortium in Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-2026: \$2,302,867 in CDBG, \$202,582 in ESG, and \$1,234,276.61 in HOME and the remaining CDBG Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act funds.
