Visiting Guidelines:

- ✓ **Photo identification must be provided.** Only current and valid identification including, driver’s license, passports, alien registration cards, visas, or a Mexican Consulate registration form, will be accepted.
- ✓ Only parents, guardians and pre-approved supportive adults authorized by the Facility Supervisor, may visit youth in the facility.
- ✓ **Visiting check-in time is 1:00 p.m. to 1:15 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. to 6:15 p.m. Visitors arriving after check-in will NOT be allowed to visit.**
- ✓ Children of **youth in custody** are allowed to visit: however, visitation must be pre-arranged due to limited space available for child visits.
- ✓ No one will be allowed to wait in the Visiting Center lobby.
- ✓ Snacks are accepted during visiting hours only, within the guidelines listed below.
- ✓ No purses, cell phones, cameras, or electronic devices of any kind are allowed in the facility.
- ✓ No tobacco products, lighters, matches, firearms, knives, or weapons of any kind are allowed.
- ✓ Hostages will not be recognized for bargaining purposes during escape attempts by youth.
- ✓ No packages are allowed into the facility. No packages can be given to youth during visits.
- ✓ All letters, photos, birthday cards, holiday cards, or other media must be delivered to youth by the United States Postal Service. No exceptions allowed.
- ✓ No Books or magazines are allowed into the facility. Approved media is furnished to youth by the facility.

Snack Guidelines:

- ✓ Snacks may be brought to the facility only on visiting days, during scheduled visiting hours.
- ✓ The snacks brought for your child will be combined with snacks brought by other parents. The pool of snacks will be available for all youth within the living unit who achieve enough points to attend evening programming.
- ✓ Upon your child’s release, all snacks brought to the facility will become the property of the Institution.
- ✓ Two types of snacks are allowed into the facility (**NO EXCEPTIONS**):
 1. 2-liter soda plastic bottles soda (**Must be diet and caffeine free only**)
 2. Individually packaged single-serving potato chips (all varieties)
- ✓ Write the youth’s first initial and last name on all snack items brought into the facility.
- ✓ All snacks must be store bought.
No glass containers of any type are allowed into the facility.
