

## **Project Description**

This project is located on 9<sup>th</sup> Street between the Tuolumne River Bridge and Pecos Avenue. The project will consist of pavement rehabilitation, streetlight modification, raised medians, and new striping that includes a bike lane that will be on both sides of 9<sup>th</sup> Street. New and modified existing ADA compliant curb ramps are proposed at appropriate intersection crossings. Traffic signal modifications are proposed at the intersections of 9<sup>th</sup> Street and Latimer Avenue and 9<sup>th</sup> Street and Pecos Avenue (in compliance with current ADA standards). The design phase is 95% complete.
