(between Tuolumne River Bridge and Pecos Ave)


Project Description

This project is located on 9th Street between the Tuolumne River Bridge and Pecos Avenue. The project will consist of pavement rehabilitation, streetlight modification, raised medians, and new striping that includes a bike lane that will be on both sides of 9th Street. New and modified existing ADA compliant curb ramps are proposed at appropriate intersection crossings. Traffic signal modifications are proposed at the intersections of 9th Street and Latimer Avenue and 9th Street and Pecos Avenue (in compliance with current ADA standards). The design phase is 95% complete.

Project Background

9th Street is a four-lane, south-north arterial road that is in need of pavement rehabilitation. The design plans and environmental approvals are complete.
