CROWS LANDING ROAD

(between SR99 and the 7th Street)



Project Description

This project is located on Crows Landing Road between State Route 99 (SR99) and the 7th Street. Construction of additional pavement to allow the installation of center two-way left turn lane on Crows Landing Road (with one through lane in each direction), and paved shoulders.

Project Background

Crows Landing Road is a two-lane, south-north arterial road that has numerous driveways from adjacent businesses. The installation of a center two-way left turn lane will allow a refuge for vehicles entering and exiting the driveways and improve safety. This work is proposed in conjunction with 7th Street Bridge Replacement Project that will have road closure of the bridge over the Tuolumne River for at least a year.
