The County of Stanislaus will be installing at-grade sidewalks and bike paths within the Airport Neighborhood, as part of the Stanislaus County Department of Public Works Measure L Airport Neighborhood Active Transportation Connectivity and Safety Project. This project includes the installation of at-grade sidewalks and Class I, Class III and Class IV Bike Paths along portions of Santa Cruz Avenue, Kerr Avenue, Empire Avenue, Mono Drive, Tenaya Drive, Tioga Drive, Monterey Ave, Hillside Drive and within the Modesto Irrigation District Easement (including Oregon Park). These improvements will provide paved active transportation routes to school and other destinations within the Airport Neighborhood.

LOCATION: See Locations on map in blue (Right).

TIMELINE: Construction is anticipated to begin in Summer 2022 and take about 5 months to complete depending on weather or unforeseen conditions. Standard work hours are 7:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m., Monday – Friday. Schedule updates will be available on the County's website at:

POSSIBLE INCONVENIENCES: "No Parking" signs will be posted along the street at least 2 days in advance of construction and will be enforced by the Police Department. All other usual parking restrictions, including no parking for street



cleaning, will still be in effect. Traffic may be delayed at the worksite to allow for construction vehicle movement, but the street will not be closed, except under unforeseen circumstances. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
