Subject: Hills Ferry Bridge Replacement Project over San Joaquin River



In March 2025, crews began construction for the Hills Ferry Bridge Replacement Project over the San Joaquin River, which is anticipated to be completed by January 2027.

Work activities will take place adjacent to the existing bridge on Hills Ferry Road, **Monday through Saturday**. The County advises motorists to expect minor delays during construction.

Upcoming Road Work Activities

April 2025

On the existing bridge at Hills Ferry Road over San Joaquin River, crews will be installing K-Rail (modular concrete barrier) along the westbound travel way to provide a protective barrier separating traffic from the adjacent work area. During this time, travelers should expect:

- Temporary one-way reverse traffic control of Hills Ferry Road to install K-Rail
- Heavy construction activity adjacent to the existing roadway

May 2025

Crews will begin construction of the bridge trestle adjacent to the existing bridge along the new alignment. During this time, travelers should expect:

- Temporary traffic delays due to construction equipment and trucks entering and exiting the job site
- Increased noise & dust

Project Staging

To minimize impacts and maintain traffic flow for travelers, construction will be completed in two main stages:

Stage 1 (Spring 2025 – Spring 2026): Construction of the new Hills Ferry Bridge

Stage 2 (Spring 2026 – Spring 2027): Open the new Hills Ferry Bridge to travelers and demolish the existing bridge
